What we do:

Dev Ethical Sustainable Crafts & Textiles (descatuk) is a group of textile professionals, fashion designers, livelihood professionals with the mission to accelerate the ethical sustainable fashion revolution to a new textile economy.

Why Fashion Revolution:

Fashion Revolution happened after April 24, 2013, when 1134 people were killed in the Rana Plaza factory complex collapse in Bangladesh. The accident was both predictable and preventable. Despite some steps forward since Rana Plaza, not enough has changed. About 75 million people work directly in the fashion and textiles industry, and about 80% of them are women. Many are subject to exploitation; verbal and physical abuse, working in unsafe conditions, with very little pay.

New Textile Economy:

The way we design, produce, and use clothes has drawbacks that are becoming increasingly clear. The textiles system operates in an almost completely linear way: large amounts of <u>non-renewable resources are extracted</u> to produce clothes that are often used for only a short time, after which the materials are <u>mostly sent to landfill or incinerated</u>. More than USD 500 billion of value is lost every year due to clothing underutilisation and the lack of recycling.

Furthermore, this take-make dispose model has <u>numerous negative environmental and societal impacts</u>. Hazardous substances affect the health of both textile workers and wearers of clothes, and they escape into the environment. When washed, some garments <u>release plastic micro fibres</u>, of which around half a million tonnes every year contribute to ocean pollution – 16 times more than plastic micro beads from cosmetics. Trends point to these negative impacts rising inexorably, with the potential for catastrophic outcomes in future. This linear system is ripe for disruption- a vision for a system that works, delivering long-term benefits – <u>a new textiles economy</u> based on the principles of a circular economy.

Young people, we believe everyone has fashion aptitude have an incredibly important role to strengthen the ethical and sustainable fashion now for future of our environment and as well as for potential employees in the fashion industry. So this is why we are inviting you to get involved and bring together consumer to understand ethical and sustainable fashion.
